Dear participant,

We appreciate that you will present a poster at the 5th Research Forum of the EAPC in Trondheim. Please read the following instructions carefully.

Poster presentation guidelines:

Please notice the following when preparing your poster:

- Poster dimensions should be maximum 80 cm (width) x 130 cm (height).
- State the title and the authors at the top of your poster in easily readable **bold** letters.
- Indicate the presenting author if different from the first author.
- The text and the illustrations should be readable from a distance of 2 meters.

The presence of authors at their posters:

The presence of Authors will be required only during the two poster viewing sessions during coffee breaks, in order to permit presenters to visit and discuss the work of others.

Poster guided tours:

As an educational opportunity, the faculty offers to visit some faculty-selected posters together with a group of participants. The aim is to focus on important posters in the field as well as posters that by the faculty is considered to be of special educational value (e.g. interesting methodology, results presentation, challenging evolution of research questions).

At the entrance of the **poster area** please **write your name** in the lists, and meet the expert there.

Poster discussion sessions:

18 posters have been selected for the two poster discussion sessions (9 posters of each poster set). Two experts will discuss and comment the posters and involve the authors in the discussion. The authors of the selected posters are requested to attend those sessions and provide for three (power-point) slides resuming their poster.



Poster awards:

Reviewers will assess the posters in two sets during the Forum. Six outstanding posters (three for each poster set) will receive an award in the Poster Highlight during the Closing Session (Olavshallen, Saturday 31st May 16:00-16:30)
